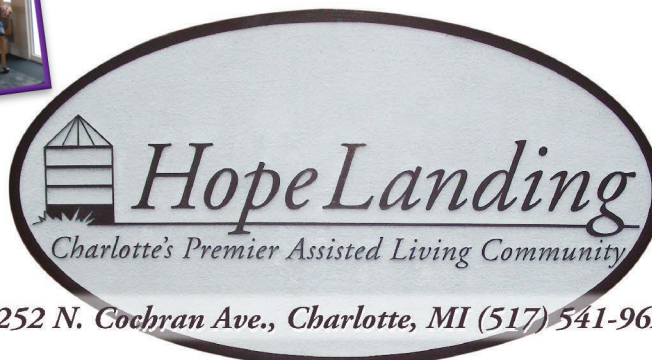
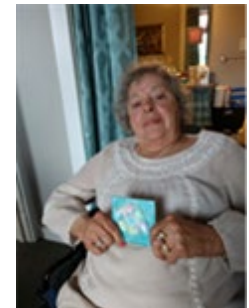


## Clay Crafting @Hope Landing

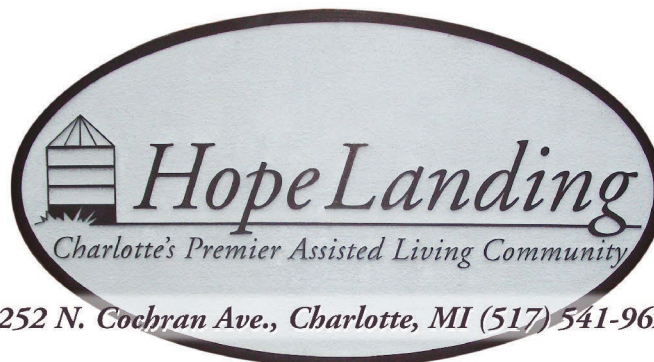
