

If you were here last year or the year before, then you are familiar with the "Giving Hope" Christmas Adopt a Family program and that's all you know. But let me go back a little farther so you know how we got to where we are now.

It used to be we would do a "Secret Santa" event where the residents would draw names and then buy a gift for that person. We would then have a Christmas party and exchange gifts. Well, it was not an easy task for many to decide on a gift and then go shopping. And of course, they would tell you that they really didn't need anything if you tried to get ideas from them. This got one of us thinking about doing something different, something to help others, so we approached the residents with the idea of helping a local family in need instead. They loved the idea, because of course, helping others is what we are supposed to do. So, we partnered with the Housing Services of Mid-Michigan right here in town and for the past 2 years we have helped 6 families (a total of 21 individuals) have a very Merry Christmas. Not only did each member of those families get some things they really needed and something special that they really wanted; they also received food for a Christmas meal.

And with the residents rallying behind us, we are happy to announce that we will be continuing this tradition in 2019.
