A few of us went on a mission to check out “*Jeff The Magician*” at the Eaton County Senior Center. He was pretty good. Maybe we will bring him here in 2020.

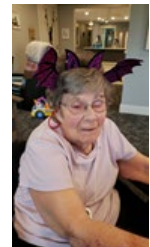
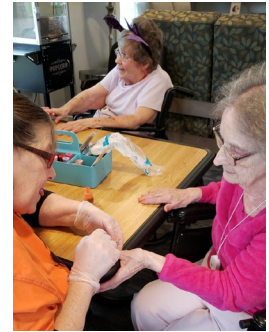


His magic was amazing. He also did some great tricks with a deck of cards.

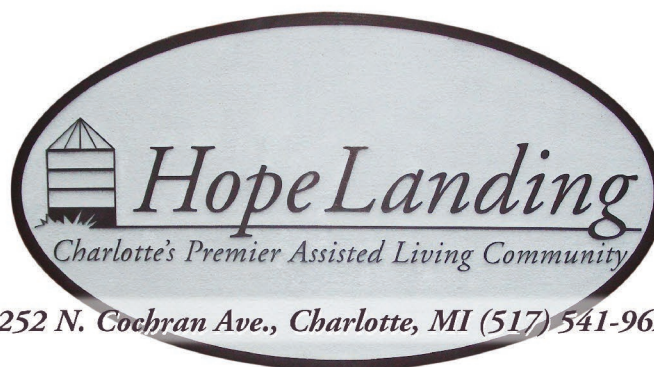


## Halloween fun at The Haven & Hope Landing
