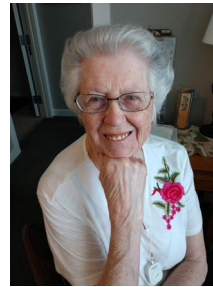
## Memorial Day and Graduation Messages

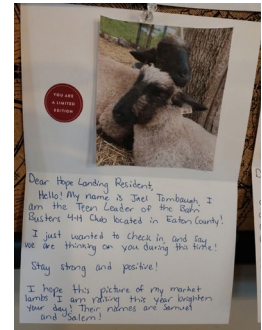

## Feeling Thankful!!

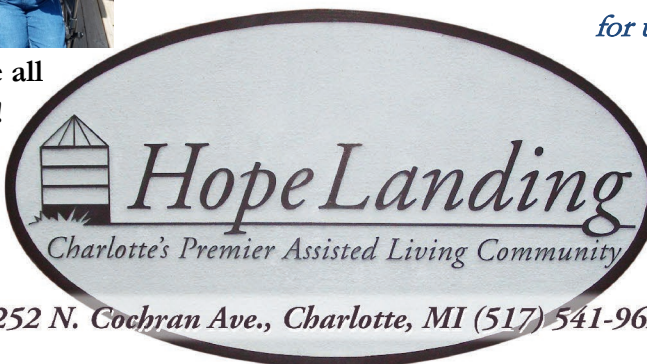
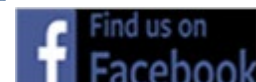
